



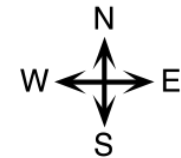

**EVENT PARKING** The Salk Institute does not have public parking. Here are nearby options:

- 1 UCSD Gravel Lot P386 [FREE & PAID options]**  
See attendant for FREE pass from 12:15-1:15 PM or use ParkMobile App [Zone 4767] to purchase permit (\$4.00/day). UCSD A/B/S/SS/V/D permits allowed.
- 2 Sanford Consortium Lot P385 [PAID]**  
Use Pay Station by stairs or ParkMobile App [Zone 4741] to purchase permit (\$4.20/hour).
- 3 Public Street Parking [FREE]**  
Salk Institute Road and Torrey Pines Scenic Drive (very limited).
- 4 Torrey Pines Gliderport Dirt Lot [FREE]**  
~1/2 mile walk to the auditorium.
- 5 UCSD Pangea Parking Structure [PAID]**  
Visitor parking in “V” spaces only. Use Pay Station or ParkMobile App [Zone 4752] to purchase permit (\$4.50/hr).

- **Availability of parking is NOT guaranteed.**
- Give extra time (~20-30 minutes) to secure parking.
- All visitors must check in with Salk Security in the South East Building.
- Take elevator or stairs to lower level.
